The Battle of the Bats 2010 Tournament is designed to provide participants an enjoyable activity. The rules are written to promote competition in a fair and safe environment. If players realize the benefits of selflessness, striving for a common cause and the development of skills, knowledge, fitness and other sport-related outcomes, they must assume many personal responsibilities. The most important of the participant's responsibilities relate to what must be done to avoid injuries to self, teammates and opponents. Although baseball is not a hazardous activity and in spite of rules to prevent injuries and equipment to protect vulnerable body parts, participation does include risk of injury. Injuries may be very slight or severe, such as bruises, lacerations, broken bones, injuries to eyes and teeth and those with long-term consequences. Although serious injuries are not common in supervised youth baseball programs, it is possible only to minimize, and not completely eliminate, this risk. Players must wear appropriate protective equipment and apparel when playing. Players are responsible for inspecting their own equipment and notifying coaches / parents of any defects.
